BEYOND THE RAINBOW



According to Director of Logistics Brian Rogers, "Those of us who survived this surreal year gained new respect and meaning for the



J.T. Bymaster is a manual, movement, and processoriented therapist and somatic educator. Certified in California as a massage therapist in 1997 J.T. has studied with many masters and has received many certificates in the fields of martial arts, chi gung, dance, somatics, and manual therapy. Currently, J.T. is a Pre-OT Kinesiology Student at SSU and has completed original research studying the effects of parental motivation on the physical activity levels of their children with disabilities.

> The Family Justice Center or FJC provides support to victims of Domestic Violence, Child Abuse, Elder Abuse, Sexual Assault, Stalking, Human Trafficking, and Homeless Victims of Crime. The FJC serves as a one-stop shop for victims, where multiple service providers and agencies work together under one roof. Without the FJC a survivor may have to go to over 23 places to receive services, all while telling their story over and over again in settings that may be scary or intimidating. But at the FJC, a survivor tells their story to a trained navigator in a safe and secure location who makes the process understandable and as comfortable as possible. Then, a community of co-located professionals in victim advocacy, civil law, mental health, prosecution, law enforcement, and more work together through the FJC to coordinate the best way to help serve the survivor--providing comprehensive, continuous, and seamless care all in one place. The FJC also provides immigration support for survivors of domestic violence and other crimes and various holistic services like yoga, art the rapy, massage therapy, and reiki, helping survivors overcome their trauma, reclaim their futures, and restore hope. 
